DART Training

I recently was privileged to be part of the <u>DART training</u> in Riga, Latvia. DART stands for Disaster Assistance and Response Team, and is a team of people who could be deployed to any disaster in the world. Sounds crazy, I know, and it is perhaps one of the most crazy and most interesting things I have ever done!

The first few days of training were about what it means to be a Project Manager in the office in case of a DART deployment. This includes everything from updating family members of those in the field, to booking flights, to sending funds, and the list could go on. It really takes a whole office team in order for a DART mission to take place on the ground! I am very excited to utilize my new-found knowledge in the future.

After my Project Manager training was complete, the DART participant training started and the true craziness began. I was joined by nineteen others from six

different nations, and for ten days we learned what it means to respond on the ground in a disaster situation. The incredible design team simulated real-life situations for us to respond to with no wi-fi, limited currency, language limitations, and even sleeping in tents! I am unable to share the specifics of the different situations with you in case one of you decides to pursue this awesome opportunity in the future, but I am happy to talk with you more about it if you are interested!

As part of this trip, my colleague and I were also able to make a quick stop at the GAiN Germany office. It was wonderful to meet the GAiN family around the world, and put a face to a name for our future interactions.
