Cyclone Idai

Many of you have probably seen on the news that last week Cyclone Idai made landfall in Mozambique. Its powerful winds and heavy rainfall caused devastation throughout the country and moved on to destroy parts of Zimbabwe and Malawi.

Sources say that this destructive storm is regarded as one of the worst tropical cyclones on record to affect Africa and the Southern Hemisphere as a whole. To date, the storm has affected more than 2.6 million people and recorded deaths of more than 500 people with hundreds more missing.

GAiN Canada has decided to partner with GAiN USA in the provision of water filters near the Zimbabwe and Mozambique border. The filters remove bacteria and protozoa to create safe drinking water, meeting the immediate needs of families and communities.

I am helping to manage this project, as the situation continues to unfold. Our goal is to provide 1,000 water filters to families who have been affected by the cyclone. If you are interested in more information, or interested in partnering with us in this disaster relief, click here.
